

TRANSFER STATIONS

The Shire operates four refuse transfer stations at Carisbrook, Talbot, Dunolly and Bealiba. Waste that can't be recycled or reused is transferred from these transfer stations to the Patho landfill at Echuca.

Our policy is to recycle all we can to reduce what is sent to landfill. Please load your trailer to allow separation of green waste and recyclables from other waste.

Remember to cover and secure your load before transporting to the transfer station.

Talbot – Rocky Flat Road	Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday 12 noon – 4pm
Dunolly – Dunolly Maryborough Road	Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday 12 noon – 4pm
Bealiba – Whitehills Road	Thursday, Saturday and Sunday 12 noon – 4pm

All sites are closed Christmas Day, New Years Day, Good Friday and Anzac Day.

Payment

Central Goldfields residents can use waste vouchers provided in their rates notice to dispose of general waste, green waste or hard rubbish at the transfer stations:

Our new recycling and waste service provides all Central Goldfields residents on a waste pickup with a commingled recycling bin (with a yellow lid) and a new red lid for the existing garbage bin.

The new service starts from 20 October 2008 (see the calendar below for collection weeks, days remain unchanged).

NEW RECYCLING BIN

Emptied fortnightly. All recyclables in one bin with a yellow lid.

These items only in recycling bins:



Aluminium steel cans, aerosols and clean foil



Phone books, envelopes, work and school papers



Plastic bottles and containers with codes 1 2 3 4 5 6 7



Milk and juice cartons



Newspapers, brochures, magazines and junk mail



Cardboard boxes, cereal and food boxes



Glass bottles and jars



240 litre

GARBAGE BIN

Emptied fortnightly. Now with a red lid.

These items only in garbage bins:



Food waste



Ceramics



Nappies (wrapped)



Polystyrene



Window glass, mirrors, Pyrex, and light globes (wrapped)



Plastics including film, wrap, and plastic packaging



140 litre

Bin placement



- Place bins near the kerb or roadside
- Face wheels/handle away from the road
- Allow a metre between bins and other objects

NO! Not in this bin!

- ✗ NO Garbage, nappies, food waste or green waste
- ✗ NO Plastic bags
- ✗ NO Packaging material
- ✗ NO Gas bottles, chemicals or hazardous waste
- ✗ NO Light globes
- ✗ NO Polystyrene
- ✗ NO Motor oil or motor oil containers
- ✗ NO Broken crockery or Pyrex
- ✗ NO Cardboard with food remains
- ✗ NO Waxed cardboard

NO! Not in this bin!

- ✗ NO Recyclables or garden waste
- ✗ NO Bricks, rubble, heavy timber, building material or scrap metal
- ✗ NO Oils, liquids, paint, chemicals, gas bottles or hazardous waste
- ✗ NO Commercial waste
